PROPERTY TAX INCREASE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 16 has properly given notice of the public hearing held October 18, 2004, to consider the Fire District's current expense budget for the 2006 calendar year, pursuant to RCW 84.55.120; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 16, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that King County Fire Protection District No. 16 requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred and refunds made, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the fire district and in its best interest; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 16 that an increase in the regular property tax levy, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred and refunds made, is hereby authorized for the 2006 levy in the amount of \$39,408.00 which is a percentage increase of 0.99 percent from the previous year.


