

Operational Permits

An operational permit is designed to allow a business or occupant to maintain, store or conduct processes that may produce a condition hazardous to life or property. These businesses are inspected on an annual basis to ensure that everything is in accordance with the International Fire Code (IFC). This permit is not issued until all violations have been remedied. Below is a list of permits:

We also issue permits for a short period of time. These permits fall into the category of Limited Permits. These permits are issued at the time of the event and are valid for the duration for the project. Examples may be local fairs or carnivals, fireworks or underground oil tank removal.
