This course does NOT authorize you to respond to any incident on behalf of any response agency.

The CERT course is 24 hours of instruction (8 sessions of three hours). Classes are Mondays during the day from 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon. To become a certified CERT graduate, there is a minimum required attendance. Class dates are: September 9, 16, 23, 30 and October 7, 14, 21, **Saturday** October 26.

To register, applicants must be at least eighteen years of age (or 13 years of age if accompanied by a parent also taking the course). Classes are limited in size and will be filled on a first-registered, first-served basis. Registration will be confirmed when NEMCo receives this form and the \$35 course fee (Please make checks payable to **City of Lake Forest Park**, sorry credit/debit cards are not accepted).
